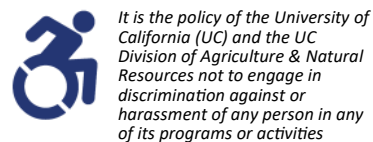

MANDATORY FAIR REQUIREMENT - YQCA ONLINE TRAINING



All Glenn County junior livestock exhibitors need to have this training complete in order to exhibit animals at the Glenn County Fair.

To register and complete this training, please visit: www.yqcaprogram.org. The confirmation number received upon completion must be entered into your Glenn County Fair online entry.

What does this mean for 4-H?

4-H does not have any management responsibilities regarding the YQCA. The fairs are responsible for letting exhibitors know about the requirement and when the training needs to be completed. 4-H staff are not responsible for notifications, in-person trainings or verification of certificates. How does an exhibitor get their certificate of completion from the Online Course?

Youth who are taking the YQCA training online would need a pass rate of 80% on a series of three quizzes to earn certification. They can repeat the module if needed. GLENN COUNTY 4-H FAIR EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS

This year Glenn County 4-H developed NEW Fair Exhibition Requirements. A few of the participation guidelines are listed below.

- Give a presentation at County Presentation Day, a Club Meeting, a Project Meeting, a qualifying county event, service clubs, school classrooms, senior citizens groups, etc. (Presentations given to neighbors, relatives, or friends DO NOT count.) **The subject of the presentation must be directly related to the project being exhibited at the Glenn County Fair.**
- If a member will be exhibiting an ABA project as well as a livestock animal, the member can choose a presentation for either project.
- Livestock exhibitors must attend the Glenn County 4-H Livestock Challenge/Field Day Event. Alternative events are the CSU 4-H Livestock Evaluation, CSU Chico State Livestock Field Days, or a related livestock event from a neighboring county.
- ABA exhibitors must attend Glenn County 4-H ABA Extravaganza Event. Alternative events are the Glenn County 4-H Quilt Show, Fashion Revue, or a related ABA event from a neighboring county.
