

## FALL WORKSHOP SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED

University of California Farm Advisor Bill Krueger today announced an upcoming workshop series.

On **September 26**, a **Home Olive Curing Workshop** will be held from 9:00 a.m. to Noon at Historic Mills Orchard near Hamilton City. Attendees will learn how to prepare four types of home-cured olives from Krueger and Pam Geisel, co-author of the California Backyard Orchard. Information will also include food safety related to home curing, variety choices for the different styles of olives and suitable equipment and utensils.
