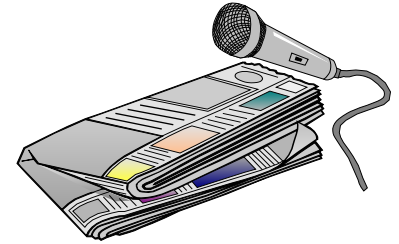

**GLENN COUNTY MASTER GARDENERS PRESENT
WORKSHOP ON VEGETABLE GARDENING**

Glenn County Master Gardeners will be presenting a workshop on Planning and Designing Your Vegetable Garden in Willows on Saturday, August 10, at Redwood Springs Gardens, 1769 Rd. FF, 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. The featured presenter will be Pam Geisel, newly-retired Coordinator of the California Master Gardening Program and Technical Advisor to the 2013 edition of the Sunset Western Garden Book, who will speak on plant varieties and pest control.

Glenn County Master Gardeners making presentations will include Glenda Babbitt on square foot gardening and raised beds, Skip Taylor on garden soils and composting, Barbara Overton on irrigation, and Amy Watson on season extenders, hoops, floating row covers, and debris netting.

The cost for attending this workshop is \$10.00 and will include plants for attendees to take home. Enrollment can be done online at the Glenn County Master Gardener Website or at the workshop on August 10. Further information is available at 530-865-1107.
