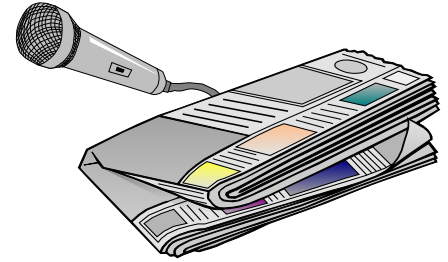

Glenn County Master Gardeners to Present Fall Workshop at Country Pumpkins

Glenn County Master Gardeners will be presenting a Fall Garden Workshop on October 12 at Country Pumpkins in Orland from 12:00 to 4:00 p.m. The workshop will include presentations by Master Gardeners on the topics of window sill gardening, fall garden to-dos, planning your home orchard, and greenhouse/hoophouse season extenders. The cost of the workshop will be \$10.00. Country Pumpkins is located at 7152 Highway 32. Gardening books will be offered for sale, and free snacks and beverages will be provided.
