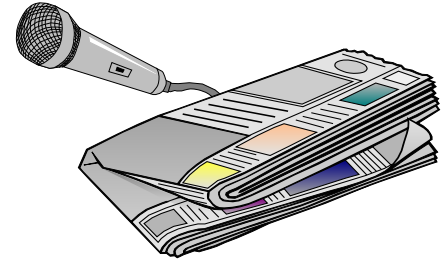

The first meeting is the Almond Institute Meeting to be held on January 27, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to Noon at the Chico Masonic Family Center, 1110 W. East Avenue, Chico. Meeting topics include:

- Honey bee safety
- Weed control and disease management
- Almond tree spacing and pruning
- Information about the Irrigated Lands Program requirements
