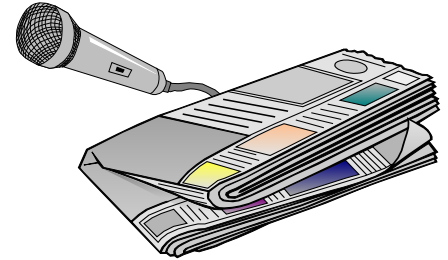

## Master Gardeners Offer New Plant Clinic in Willows

Glenn County Master Gardeners are adding new Plant Clinic hours in Willows beginning on March 2nd. The Master Gardener Plant Clinic, which currently offers services every Wednesday from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. at the U.C.C.E. office in Orland, will be answering questions about home gardens at the Willows Library from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. on the first Wednesday of every month. The Master Gardener Plant Clinic provides a chance for community members to get research-based information about growing vegetables, shrubbery, ornamentals, lawns, trees and other plants in your own yard. Landscaping tips for a drought tolerant garden are available, as well as information about existing and potential pests that may affect your garden's success.

The Glenn County Master Gardener Program is a service of U.C. Cooperative Extension. The purpose of the program is to "extend to the public research-based information verified by UC experts about home horticulture and pest management." The Glenn County program began in 2011, and since then has provided garden information through workshops, newspaper articles, fair booths, the Plant Clinic, and a host of personal contacts with the community.
