

2012 GLENN COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

Five outstanding Glenn County 4-H graduating seniors were selected April 4, 2012, to receive a total of \$2,600 in scholarships, reports Glenn County 4-H Program Representative Deanna Rogers.
