

2015 GLENN COUNTY LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AWARD SELECTED

Two Glenn County 4-H Jr./Teen Leaders were selected for the Leadership Development Award for the 2014-2015 4-H year, reports Jamie Marron, 4-H Program Representative.

Lester "Bucky" Squier IV of the Willows 4-H Club was selected as our Leadership Development Award recipient after being interviewed on April 1, 2015.
