GLENN COUNTY 4-H PLANS ANNUAL SUMMER CAMP

The Glenn County 4-H Youth Development Program sponsors a resident youth summer camp every year for youth 4th-9th grades. (Current 4-H membership is not required.) This year's camp is scheduled **for Thursday, June 18th, through Sunday, June 21st**, reports Jamie Marron, 4-H Program Representative. The camp facilities are located at Camp Tehama in the Lassen National Forest near Mill Creek, California. The average participation is about 80-100 campers from Glenn County each year. The camp is staffed by 4-H personnel, volunteer adult leaders and high school age camp counselors. The 4-H Camp is a rustic camp with the philosophy of providing an exciting outdoor educational experience to as many youth as possible. The goal of the Glenn County 4-H Camp program is to provide youth an opportunity for growth and development in mental, physical, social and leadership skills.

The cost is \$75.00 per person, a \$10.00 late fee will be charged after deadline if space is still available. There is an additional \$35.00 fee if the youth is not a current 4-H member. The deadline for reservations is **Wednesday, April 15th, 2015**, and are on a first come, first served basis. For those adults willing to attend as staff (with duties and responsibilities), the cost is \$50.00. Adults are required to attend two of six planning meetings, but are encouraged to attend all six. The schedule of the remaining planning meetings are as follows: Thursday, April 9th, Monday, April 27th, Wednesday, May 20th, Wednesday, June 10th at 6:30 p.m., at the Glenn County Cooperative Extension Office in Orland.
