## STATE 4-H FIELD DAY RESULTS

Approximately 13 Glenn County 4-H members participated in the State 4-H Field Day at UC Davis on Saturday, May 30, 2015, reports 4-H Program Representative Jamie Marron. There were Glenn County 4-H members representing Clover and Lake 4-H Clubs and participating with more than 1,500 4-H members from all other counties. During the event, 4-H members participated in a variety of contests including State 4-H Presentation Day, State 4-H Fashion Revue, Entomology Contest, State 4-H Plant Science Contest, State 4-H Judging Event and various activities.

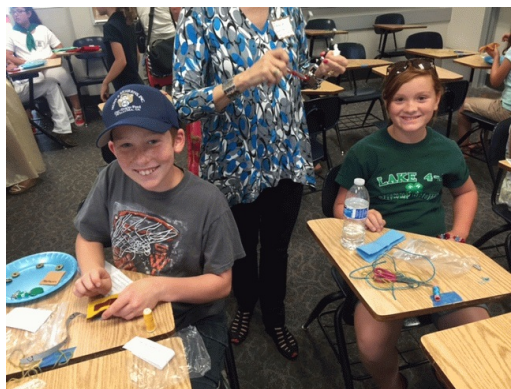
The State 4-H Judging Contest and State Entomology Contest took place in Wellman Hall on the UC Davis Campus. 4-H members judged an everyday activity, comparing four items and using their ability to think, reason, and make logical and scientific judgments. Gracie Flowerdew in the Intermediate Division and Raelene Garnett in the Senior Division, of the Clover 4-H Club, received a blue. In the Senior Division of the Entomology Contest, Danelle Garnett of the Clover 4-H Club received a red and Raelene Garnett of the Clover 4-H Club received a blue. During this contest, the 4-H members were tested on their knowledge on the human and environmental impacts of insects, biology, taxonomy, anatomy, behavior and insect disease as well as identifying 25-30 common local insects.

Danelle Garnett of the Clover 4-H Club was a busy 4-H'er that day because she also participated in the State 4-H Plant Science Contest, Senior Division, where she was tested on three parts: judging, identification and written knowledge of horticulture plants and plant science techniques. Danelle took 8<sup>th</sup> place and received a participation certificate.

Three Lake 4-H Club members participated in the State 4-H Fashion Revue at Olson Hall. The 4-H members participated in modeling and showmanship of their clothing and textile project with an Alice in Wonderland theme,

“Through the Looking Glass”. A medal was won by Clarrisa Wetz in the Senior Division, Costume Challenge. In the Traditional Category for Junior Division, Lucia Salinas was a medal winner. In the Traditional Category for Intermediate Division, Ashley Pinedo received a blue.

The final event for the day was the State 4-H Presentation Day. Four Glenn County 4-H members gave presentations in the form of a demonstration or a talk. Sydney Del Pape, Carson Karle, and Hannah Wetz of Lake 4-H Club all received a blue. A gold was won by Gracie Flowerdew of the Clover 4-H Club. Kenzie Eddy of the Lake 4-H Club attended the Field Day and participated in the State Field Day sewing activities. Overall it was a great 4-H State Field Day for Glenn County 4-H members.
