Corn Maze Glenn County 4-H Fundraiser

Country Pumpkins has generously offered 100% of proceeds from the Corn Maze to Glenn County 4-H Clubs each Saturday and Sunday through October from 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. The cost is \$3.00 per person - children under 4 free. The Corn Maze is located at 7152 Hwy 32 in Orland.

Each year Country Pumpkins plants a plot of corn, nurtures it to maturity, cuts a maze, then turns it over to the Glenn County 4-H clubs to use as a fund-raiser. The local 4-H clubs hold a work day to prepare the maze for the October opening, and each club takes a turn hosting a weekend day. All proceeds collected from the daytime maze go back to the 4-H program. This year's maze is ten acres and more challenging than ever, filled with twists and turns sure to challenge all who attempt to find their way through.
