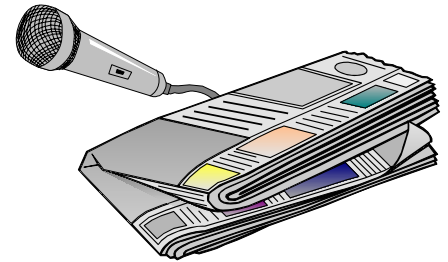

Citrus Growers Meet in Chico, Friday, October 13th

A Citrus Research Growers' Educational Seminar will be held Friday, October 13th, at the Chico Masonic Family Center, 1110 W. East Avenue, Chico. This Citrus Research Board and University of California Cooperative Extension sponsored seminar will run from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The meeting will feature University of California speakers from UC Riverside, UC Davis and the Kearney Agricultural Center, and local UCCE farm advisors. Topics will include:

- * **Refresher on the Basics of Citrus Tree Physiology**
- * **Soil Moisture Monitoring in Citrus Irrigation Management**
- * **Approaches to Soft Scale Management in Citrus**
- * **Update on Mandarin Rind Breakdown Research**
