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4-H Mercury Vapor Light Exchange Fundraiser Ongoing

RHA, Inc. and Glenn County 4-H have been partners together in the Light Exchange Program for a few years. This program is still available. Glenn County 4-H has received a generous donation from partnering with RHA, Inc. You can replace all of your old mercury vapor yard light fixtures with new energy-efficient high pressure sodium yard light fixtures at NO COST TO YOU under a PG&E program. To qualify to receive FREE yard lights, you: must be a PG&E customer. Light(s) being exchanged must be mercury vapor yard light in working order; and must provide a copy of your PG&E bill (to verify PG&E customer status). For every mercury vapor yard light installed by RHA, 4-H receives \$7.50. The goal is to have as many lights replaced as possible.
