2014 GLENN COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED

One outstanding University of California Cooperative Extension Glenn County 4-H graduating senior was selected April 8, 2014, to receive a \$1000 4-H scholarship. The individual receiving the scholarship is Tanner Bailey.
