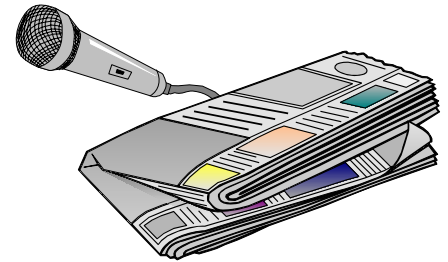

Over 300 Glenn County 4-H members, leaders and family members participated in the Annual 4-H Presentation Event held Friday evening, February 24th, at the Willows Intermediate School, reports 4-H Program Representative Deanna Rogers.

The A.W. Bramwell Memorial Plaque was won this year by R. Brandon Thomson & Lane Gruenwald of the Capay 4-H Club. This award was started in 1977 and is given to the top first time, 4th or 5th grade presenter. This year, R.
