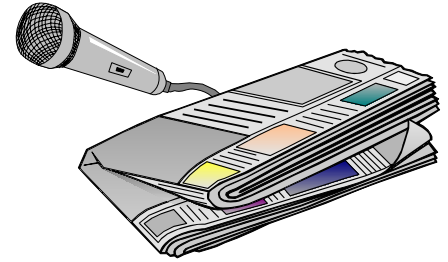

UNITED WAY BOWL-A-THON A SUCCESS

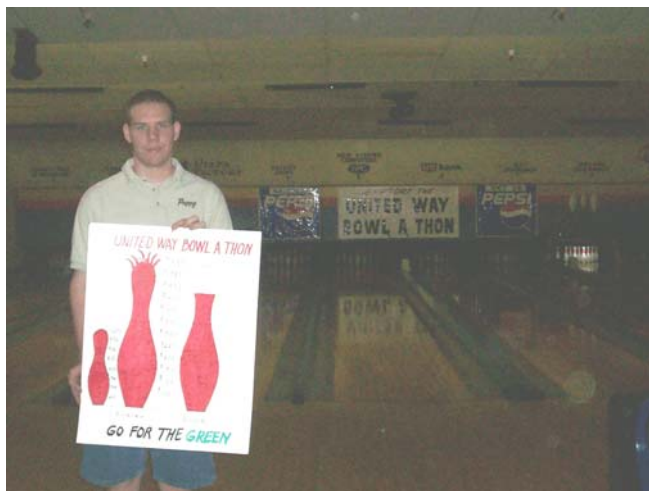
