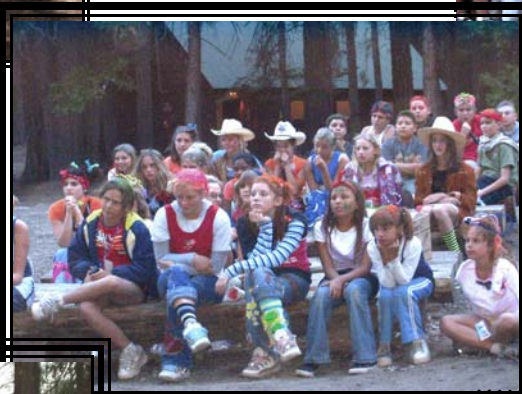
Key Leaders' Dinner Meeting

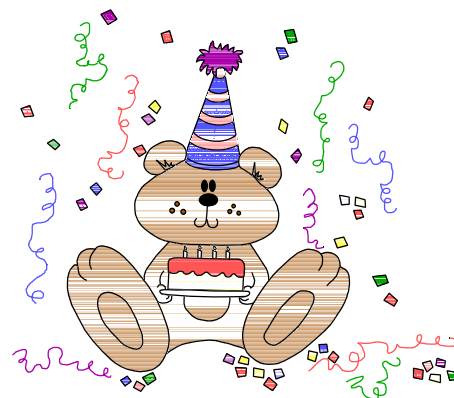
