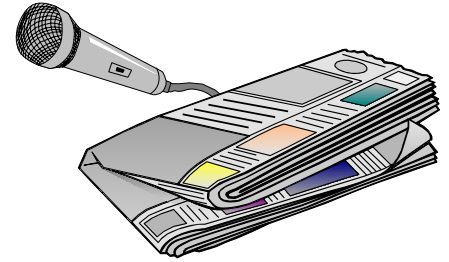

4-H Mercury Vapor Light Exchange Fundraiser Ongoing

RHA, Inc. and Glenn County 4-H have been partners together in the Light Exchange Program. This program will be available through the summer and possibly longer. Glenn County 4-H has received a generous donation from partnering with RHA, Inc. You can replace all of your old mercury vapor yard light fixtures with new energy-efficient high pressure sodium yard light fixtures at NO COST TO YOU under a PG&E program. To qualify to receive FREE yard lights, you: must be a PG&E ag-related or rural customer; light(s) being exchanged must be mercury vapor yard light in working order; and must provide a copy of your PG&E bill (to verify PG&E customer status). For every mercury vapor yard light installed by RHA, 4-H receives money. The goal is to have as many as possible signed up as possible.
